Your Role and Responsibility

Standens Barn Primary School child protection reporting procedures:

Cause for concern observed or discussed.

OR

Disclosure is made which suggests a child is at immediate risk of significant harm

Report a concern ASAP by discussing it with a member of the school's 'Safeguarding Team' and record it using a yellow cause for concern record sheets.

Discuss with a member of the safeguarding team immediately and without delay.

Be factual and as specific as possible regarding times, dates, names etc..

'Safeguarding Team' agree appropriate course of action according to the **Northamptonshire Thresholds and Pathways** and, if necessary, a referral is made to Social Services and other relevant authorities.
