Reading

Please read with your child at least 4 times a week at home.

Every time your child reads their reading book at home please write in their Reading Record Book/Read Write Inc record. (date, book title, comment).

Your child can change their book daily first thing in the morning if they have read it at home.

Each time your child reads at home they will get a red token to put in the class token pot. This is to help encourage them to read at home. The class with the most tokens wins a reading trophy at the end of every term. Each term the classes aim to beat their previous term's number of reads.

Home support

As well as reading at least 4 times week with an adult, children will be expected to complete weekly MyMaths homework from Term 2. Tomorrow the children will bring home their first set of spellings. These are handed out each Friday in readiness for the following Friday. Your children will receive 2 smiley faces for correct spellings. Year 2 Curriculum

Our theme for Term 1 is all about Rainforests. With the exception of Maths, RE, PSHE, and ICT all subjects will be linked to this theme in some way:

<u>Writing:</u>

All our texts and writing genres this term will be connected to our 'Rainforests' theme. Through these units of work, the children will develop their speaking and listening, reading and writing skills:

- animal fact files.
- Scene descriptions

<u>Maths:</u>

We will be spending time this term on place value and addition and subtraction.

<u>Geography</u>

We will be locating where the rainforests are, locating the seven continents and the five oceans. We will be learning about the equator.

<u>Science</u>

We will be learning about living things and their habitats in the rainforests. **PSHE**

We will start by understanding our feelings and know who to go to if we need to talk about our worries. We will also look at the scientific names for our private body parts and look at the NSPCC 'Pantosaurus' website and talk about keeping ourselves safe.

Computing systems and networks

We will be learning about computing systems, networks and $\ensuremath{\mathsf{IT}}$ around us.

<u>Art</u>

Children will be creating Rainforest art based on the French artist Henri Rousseau. They will use a variety of different materials and techniques such as cutting, sticking and layering.

<u> Music:</u>

During this term, the children will be learning to use their voices expressively by singing traditional songs and rhymes. They will learn what is meant by a steady beat 'pulse' and 'rhythm.' The children will create rhythmic patterns based on the beats in words and phrases.
