## Literacy

### Phonics and Reading:

- + Notice some print, such as the first letter of their name, a bus, a door number or a familiar logo.
- + Recognise my own name.
- + Repeat words and phrases from familiar stories.

### Writing:

- + To know how to write my name.
- + To begin to know how to write labels.
- + To begin to know how to write for different purposes, for example during role play.

## Personal, Social and Emotional Development

### BEST:

- + To know what BEST means in our school. To know that I am similar and different to others.

### Keeping myself safe:

- + To know and talk about how to keep my body healthy and safe, including healthy eating, physical activity & tooth brushing.
- + To know and to name ways to stay safe around medicines.
- + To know how to stay safe in my home, classroom and outside.
- + To know age-appropriate ways to stay safe online.
- + To know and be able to name adults in my life and those in my community who keep me safe.

## Physical Development

### Fine Motor

- + To know how to use my 'pinchy fingers' to pick up my pencil.
- + To know how to hold a pencil correctly to make marks.

### Gross Motor—Gymnastics

- + To know how to balance an move along benches / mats safely and jump safely

## Expressive Arts and Design

### Creating With Materials

- + To know how to look closely and use the correct colours and skin tones when drawing a self portrait.
- + To know how to represent my family using loose parts.
- + To know how to explore a range of collage materials such as cardboard, buttons, felt and tissue paper to create a self portrait focusing on key facial features.
- + To know how to build different types of houses and buildings using large and small wooden bricks/ block play resources.

### Music:

- + To know songs about our bodies such as *I've Got a Body and Head, Shoulders Knees and Toes*.

## Communication and Language

- To know how to listen carefully and why listening is important.
- To Know that sounds in the environment are different and how.
- To know how to talk about what I like and why, in front of a small group of children

## Understanding of the World

- + To know the names of the external parts of my body such as leg, arm, head, foot.
- + To know that I looked different as a baby and I can talk about how I have changed.
- + To know that as a baby I played with different toys to those I play with now.
- + To know that I live in Northampton and that this can be found on a map/ Google Earth
- + To know features of the environment in which I live, including houses, school, shop, green spaces/ park, trees.
- + To know that all families are different and why my family is special.
- + To know who is in my family and to talk about and describe them.

## Maths

- + To know how to match objects.
- + To know how to sort objects into different categories.
