We will continue to use the reading format of an extract which will be followed by comprehension questions. Children are also required to read twice a week and for this to be recorded on BOOM Reader

Maths: Maths homework will be set on a Friday and be expected to be completed by the following Thursday. This will be a mixture of Maths.co.uk and arithmetic questions.
