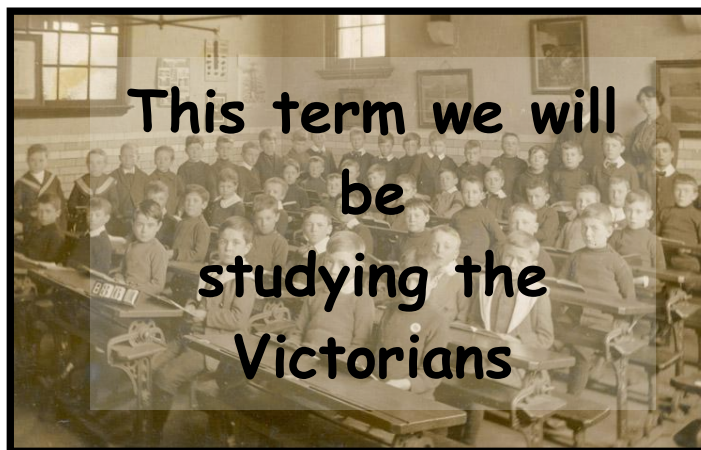
- To know where the Victorian period fits into British history
