Dear Parents / Carers of pupils in Year 3

Our topic next term is called "Shoes". We will be studying our local history, local geography and designing our own shoe in DT. This will also form part of our literacy work.

As part of the unit, I have planned a trip to **Northampton Shoe Museum and Art Gallery on Thursday May 14th.**

We will travel to Northampton Museum and Art Gallery by coach, and we have planned two workshops that look at the development of the shoe industry and how that has impacted Northampton. These workshops invite children to take a closer look around the museum and interact with the exhibits to learn something new.

On the day, we will leave school at around 9:30am and arrive back at school around 12:00pm. Lunch will continue as normal and no adaptations are needed for this day.

The total cost of the trip will be £5. Standens Barn Primary School has already considerably subsidised this visit, however, for the experience to go ahead a **£5 contribution** per child is needed by **Thursday 30th April.**

Payment will need to be made using the Arbor App / parent portal. If your child is entitled to Pupil Premium then the cost of this trip will be £3.

Please note that by paying for the trip you are giving your consent for your child to attend and no further slip needs to be returned.

This trip represents very good value for money and is a fantastic opportunity for our pupils to further their knowledge, understanding and enjoyment of their studies. We hope you can support us to provide this valuable experience for the children.
