Homework reminder-

It is an expectation for all children to be completing their homework every week.

Reading must be recorded on BOOM Reader. A minimum of 2 reads must be recorded each week and a comprehension activity will also be sent out (both checked on a Thursday).

Maths is set through MyMaths. There are 2 parts set each week. One on what is being learnt in class and the other on their times table fluency (checked on Thursdays).

Spellings are set each Friday and tested the following Friday.
