Homework reminder-

It is expected that all children complete their homework each week. In the lead-up to the SATs, children will be required to complete one mini-assessment from each of the three revision booklets, along with their weekly spellings.

Following the SATs, normal homework expectations will resume.

Spellings: Our spelling tests are on Friday mornings with children receiving their new spellings the same day. The week's spellings will be communicated each week.

Reading: Reading homework is sent on a Friday and be expected to be completed and returned the following Thursday. We will continue to use the reading format of an extract which will be followed by comprehension questions.

Maths: Maths homework will be set on Thursdays and be expected to be completed by the following Thursday. This will be a mixture of Maths.co.uk and arithmetic questions.
