Tudor World trip

Dear Parents and Carers,

Welcome to year 5! It has been wonderful to meet your children on transfer day and transition mornings.

For our first topic in Year 5, the children will be focusing on the Tudors and learning about the history of this exciting period. On **Tuesday 29th September**, we will be visiting Tudor World in Stratford-upon-Avon as part of our Tudor studies. This curriculum trip will allow us to explore artefacts from the Tudor period, investigate the Kings and Queens and explore the historic city of Stratford-Upon-Avon with William Shakespear.

The cost of the trip is **£23** which represents excellent value for money as it includes 3 workshops at the Tudor World Museum, tour of Stratford with Shakespear and coach travel on the day. The payment system will be set up on Arbor for payment from today; this is due by **Monday 14th September**. We have set the payment up early to allow you to best budget for this expense.

(If you are in receipt of pupil premium, the total cost will be £17. If you think you may be entitled to pupil premium, the school office will be able to offer guidance.)

To allow for travel time we will leave Standens Barn at 8:30am and we will return slightly later than usual. We aim to be back at school for **4:30pm**, however we will update this on the day to allow for traffic. I will send out full details in September for this visit.

Please note that all free school meals children will have a packed lunch ordered for them. These lunches do not include a drink. If you have ordered hot meals then they will need to be cancelled for this date. All children (unless free school meals) **will need to bring a packed lunch** for the day in a disposable carrier bag if possible- whatever your child brings with them they will need to look after.
