Dear Parents/Carers

Welcome to Year 3/4

We hope your child had enjoyed their time with us in Year 3/4 last week. When your child joins Year 3/4 in September, our first topic will be "Chocolate". We will be looking at making, packaging, designing and advertising chocolate products. We will also be studying the Aztec civilization.

As part of the topic, we have planned a trip to Cadbury World for Thursday 1st October 2026. We will take a tour and take part in the 4D cinema experience. The trip also includes a workshop with a Cadbury specialist focusing on how chocolate products are developed from "Bean to Bar".

The total cost of the trip will be £28

(If you are in receipt of pupil premium, the total cost will be £23. If you think you may be entitled to pupil premium, the school office will be able to offer guidance.)

The trip includes coach travel, admission to the Cadbury World Exhibition, 4D cinema experience, a 1-hour workshop and a chocolate treat to bring home!

A final payment will be due by 10th September 2026. Payments can be made on Arbor from 14th July at 4pm.

This trip represents very good value for money and is a fantastic opportunity for our pupils to further their knowledge, understanding and enjoyment of their studies. We hope you can support us to provide this valuable experience for the children. Unfortunately, if we do not receive enough contributions, the trip will need to be cancelled.

Please also be aware that, on the day of the trip, as there is some distance to travel to Birmingham, the coaches will be leaving at around 8 am and returning at around 4.15pm.

Therefore, children will be unable to use the breakfast club facility on this day. Children will also need a packed lunch. Please note that all free school meals children will have a packed lunch ordered for them. These lunches do not include a drink. If you have ordered hot meals, then they will need to be cancelled for this date.
